### **Vandals and Destructive Patrons Policy**

Vandalism consists of the willful or malicious destruction, disfigurement, or defacement of property by means of cutting, tearing, breaking or marking. These activities are against the law. Examples of vandalism include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Deliberately cutting, tearing, marking, spitting, or putting other body fluids onto library materials, equipment, furniture or facilities.
2. Defacing walls or signs.
3. Damaging furniture or facilities such as restrooms.
4. Breaking windows.
5. Maliciously altering, deleting, damaging or destroying any computer system, program or data.
